



Keeping North County DanceArts safe

Protocols for our faculty, staff, and students



- Stop handshaking/hugs - use other non-contact methods of greeting
- Temperature check is required of all persons entering the lobby with a contact thermometer - persons with a temperature of 100 degrees (F) will not be allowed to enter the lobby or classroom/dance floor
- Face masks are required in lobby areas (per local governing agency mandate); masks are not required once in the classroom/dance floor
- Clean hands after sign in, at the door of the classroom/dance floor before and after class and at any time when entering and exiting the classroom/dance floor for any reason and at regular intervals
- Avoid touching face and cover coughs and sneezes
- Students, staff and instructors are encouraged to disinfect surfaces like doorknobs, table, desks, seating areas, water cooler buttons, ballet barres and handrails before and after use and alternatively as necessary with antiviral wipes or sanitizer.
- Non-essential visitors will not be allowed to linger in lobbies while classes are in progress, especially those with compromised immune systems, infants, and the elderly
- Students, staff instructors and essential visitors will be required to bring a personal water bottle for personal use; no cups will be provided
- Students, staff, instructors and essential visitors are encouraged to bring a personal size hand sanitizer
- No outside food or drink is allowed in lobby areas or classrooms/dance floors
- Dancers are to come to class prepared with the appropriate dance attire, including leotards, tights, shoes, hair pulled back as required by class; there is no 'borrowing' of shoes or dance wear in the studio. Those dancers arriving without the complete and proper attire will be sent home
- Parents **MUST** pick up dancers **IMMEDIATELY** after class. All dancers of driving age **MUST** leave the premises after class unless waiting for a following class. Dancers may wait in the lobby areas for no more than one (1) hour between classes. Dancers may not enter the studio earlier than fifteen (15) minutes prior to their first class. Doors will lock ten (10) minutes after class start. There will be no entry after doors are locked
- Non-essential accessories, clothing, etc. will not be allowed in the lobby areas or classrooms/dance floors; all bags, shoes, clothing, accessories must be removed from the lobby areas and/or classrooms/dance floors at the end of the day. All remaining items will be discarded at the end of the day
- Practice safe distancing while on the dance floor
